Relay: Roaring For A Cure

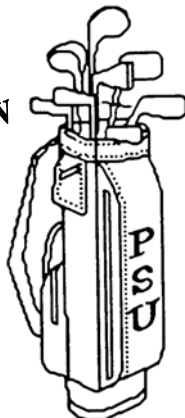

Date and Time: **Friday May 8th** with a shotgun start at **12:45 p.m.** (rain or shine). Please arrive approximately one half hour prior to the start time to register. A free lunch will be provided to all golfers.

Location: **Groff's Farm Golf Club, 650 Pinkerton Road, Mount Joy, PA 17552**

Golf Cost: **\$75 per golfer.** Your fee includes green fees, golf cart, beer, soda, lunch, and a dinner following the outing. The lunch and our honored guest speaker are being provided courtesy of **BC USA** and the beverages during the outing are being provided courtesy of **Wheatland Federal Credit Union.**

Dinner Cost: If you would like to attend the dinner only, the cost is \$25 per person.

Sponsorship: Sponsorship is needed to make this event a success! There are many ways to help:

Blue/Hole Sponsor - \$100 and includes signage either at a tee box or green along the course and a listing in the program. The fee will be reduced to \$75 if you have previously sponsored a hole. Coach Bradley is in his tenth year supervising one of the nation's top defenses. In addition to the defensive backs, Bradley also has coached five other positions, coordinated the special teams and served as recruiting coordinator, bringing numerous prep standouts to Penn State throughout his tenure.

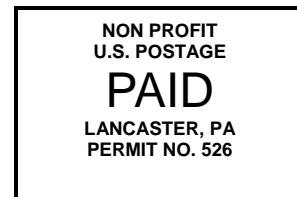
