### Saturday, October 8, 2005

Our annual Chapter tailgate will be held on Saturday, October 8th, at Beaver Stadium, prior to the PSU vs. Ohio State football game. An evening kick-off has been scheduled, but the exact time is still being determined due to television requirements, likely at 7:30 or 8:00pm. Regardless, you will have plenty of time to enjoy our tailgate festivities!

The tailgate will include a buffet cookout catered by Prospectors BBQ of State College served from **3:30pm – 6:30pm**. Menu will include award-winning pulled pork barbecue/baguette, chicken sandwiches (tangy barbecue, spicy Cajun, plain), 1/2 pound burgers (cheese, toppings), baked beans, creamy coleslaw, homemade pasta salad, chips and cookies. Beverages provided include soda, beer and wine. Cost is only \$20 for adults and \$10 for kids 10 and under. ## Hershey Park Service Day

On Saturday, August 20th, 21 volunteers representing the Penn State Club of Lancaster County turned out on a foggy, overcast day to work an eight-hour shift at Hershey Park in order to earn money for the club's scholarship fund. Eventually, the fog burned off and the day turned hazy, hot and humid. Representing Penn State classes from the 1950's to present, the volunteers helped the regular Hershey staff on water rides, kiddie rides, the carousel, the Ferris wheel, bumper cars, and more. The volunteer group represented Penn Staters, their spouses, and friends that they recruited for the fundraising effort. A big thank you goes out to every one of them.

Hershey Park does not pay the volunteers for working but instead makes a contribution to the non-profit organization that they represent. The amount of the contribution is a function of the number of volunteer hours worked. At the time of the newsletter publication, Hershey had not completed a final calculation of the hours worked. Based on preliminary estimates, it is anticipated that approximately \$1,000 has been raised for the scholarship fund. So, one more Lancaster County student will receive some help with their educational expenses.

After completing their work shift in the park, the volunteers were permitted to stay in the park until closing and each worker received a voucher for a return visit to the park in 2005 or 2006. We are always looking for more volunteers. If 75 people volunteer, the scholarship fund would receive a boost of \$3,500!
