In 1938, the BEARS officially joined the American Hockey League and have remained a fixture in the AHL for 70 consecutive seasons. The HERSHEY BEARS have claimed the Calder Cup as American Hockey League Champions nine times in their illustrious existence, most recently in the 2005-2006 season. The BEARS tied the original Cleveland Barons' all-time record when they won their ninth Calder Cup championship in 2006. Despite falling just short in a bid to win back-to-back titles, the *Bears* posted the league's best overall record in 2006-07, and set a franchise record for most wins in a season with 51. The future does indeed look bright for the American Hockey League's longest running and most successful franchise.

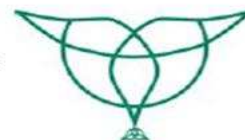
