**PSU CHAPTER VOLUNTEER DAY
IN HERSHEY PARK
Saturday, August 19, 2006
8:45am – 5:00pm**

Once again members and friends of the Penn State Lancaster Chapter are volunteering their time to raise money for the Chapter's scholarship fund. The Lancaster County Chapter of the Penn State Alumni Association awards five \$1000 scholarships each year to Lancaster County high school seniors who enroll at Penn State campus in the fall semester following their high school graduation. If we have 30 volunteers working that day, we could raise \$1,400 for the scholarship fund!

This year the Penn State Club's volunteer day at Hershey Park is Saturday, August 19, 2006. No training or special skills are required. Volunteers will assist the paid staff at the major rides by enforcing height restrictions, safety rules and other general duties. Volunteers are not paid, but Hershey donates the \$5.85 hourly wage to our non-profit organization. In addition to raising money for the scholarship fund, you get a free pass to the park!

Here are the important facts:

1. Volunteers must be at least 18 years old. They do not need to be a member of the Lancaster Penn State Club.
2. Volunteers need to work from 8:45 AM to 5:00 PM (with a short lunch break) on Saturday, August 19th.
3. Volunteers are permitted to eat lunch in the regular employee commissary and receive the discounted employee rate.
4. After finishing their shift, volunteers may stay in the Park until it closes and ride for free!
5. In addition, all volunteers will receive a voucher at the end of their shift to return to the Park free of charge in either 2006 or 2007.

Remember, you get to remain in the park the day that you work and you also get a voucher to return for another visit during the 2006 or early 2007 season, free! Plus, our Chapter Scholarship Fund benefits from the donation of your valuable time.

Lancaster County Chapter of the Penn State Alumni Association Annual Golf Outing

Date & Time: Friday May 12th with a shotgun start at 12:45 p.m. (rain or shine). Please arrive approximately one half hour prior to the start time to register. A free hot dog lunch will be provided to all golfers.

Location: Four Season Golf Course, 949 Church Street, Landisville, PA 17538

Golf Cost: \$75 per golfer. Your fee includes green fees, golf cart, beer, soda, hot dog lunch, and a dinner following the outing (barbecue chicken and ribs, baked potato, corn, fresh fruit, assorted snacks, rolls and butter, beverages and dessert).

Dinner Cost: If you would like to attend just the dinner, the cost is \$25 per person.

Sponsorship: Sponsorship is needed to make this event a success! There are three ways to help:

Blue/Hole Sponsor - \$100 and includes signage either at a tee box or green along the course and a listing in the program. The fee will be reduced to \$75 if you have previously sponsored a hole. All Blue/Hole sponsors will be included in a special drawing for two free tickets to the first home Penn State football game.

White/Program Sponsor - \$25 and includes a listing in the program.

Door Prize Sponsor – any donated items, such as golf balls, gift certificates and other giveaway items are also needed.

All sponsors will be recognized at the prizes and awards ceremony that will follow the outing and in the Chapter's annual countywide newsletter mailing sent to over 6,000 PSU alumni in the Lancaster County area.

Prizes: Prizes will be awarded to the team with the lowest gross score, the two teams with the lowest net score, the golfers closest to the pin on four various holes, the golfer with the straightest drive, and the golfer with the longest drive. In addition, there will be a \$5,000 cash prize for a hole-in-one and two other hole-in-one prizes. Door prizes will also be given out to those in attendance at the dinner.
