With three week's remaining before the Nittany Lion basketball team officially tips of the season vs. Penn in the Bryce Jordan Center on Nov. 13, Penn State student season ticket sales for men's basketball have moved past 1,000. The surge in student season tickets marks a 37 percent increase over last season and follows on the heels of a school-record 27 wins and first-ever NIT Championship. Overall season ticket sales to the general public have also seen a marked increase of 17 percent over last season with more than 4,600 distributed. Penn State will play an exhibition game with Slippery Rock on Fri., Nov. 6 at 6:00 p.m. which will be immediately followed by "Rally in the Valley" prior to the Ohio State football game. 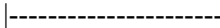

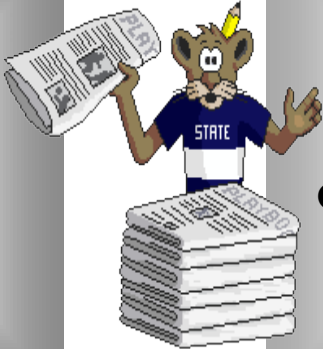

- **Driver education** -- Amos Neyhart taught America's first classes for driver education teachers at Penn State in 1936, three years after he began the nation's first driver education course at nearby State College High School.
- **Engineers everywhere** -- One in 50 professionally licensed engineers in the U.S. is a Penn State graduate.
- **Geraniums** -- Penn State researchers

developed the world's first commercially successful geranium grown from seed, the Nittany Lion Red.

- **Meteorologists** -- One in every four meteorologists in the United States is a Penn State graduate.
- **Toymaker** -- Herman Fisher, co-founder and longtime chairman of the board of Fisher Price, one of the nation's largest toymakers, graduated from PSU in 1921.
