Club Bus Trip and Tailgate Party to Highlight Michigan Game

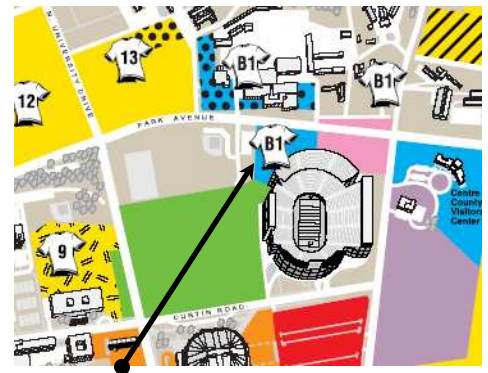
Details for our annual Beaver Stadium tailgate are out and, if tradition holds, it'll be a blast.

Service Project Update

As anticipated, the response to our collection of items from the *Ronald McDonald House Wish List* has been incredible and we **have had to add additional baskets.**

The Ronald McDonald House, located in Hershey, provides temporary housing to families of children hospitalized at Penn State Children's Hospital and supports other programs to assist children of Central PA. If you have not yet donated, or wish to donate more, there is still time. At each chapter event, between now and the holidays, we will continue to collect items from the wish list of the Ronald McDonald House. The wish list (right column) is also posted on the chapter website. Special plans are being made for the Ohio State TV Party at the Back Page Restaurant (Oct 25). Those who donate an item (or money) will be eligible to win PSU prizes.

While we've decided to focus on the wish list, other opportunities to get involved in this worthwhile organization are detailed on their website. They are in the midst of a major capital campaign to expand the residence by 15 bedrooms. This expansion is necessary because of the high occupancy needs and the frequency of a waiting list.

Also, a major source of funds (\$20,000 raised in 2007) comes from the recycling of "glossy magazines". Any "glossy" magazine or catalogue can be dropped off at Darrenkamp's in E-town, Penn Cinema in Lititz, or VFW Post 5956 in Manheim. Watch for the green "magazine" containers at these locations – not only do you recycle, but the Ronald McDonald House benefits greatly.

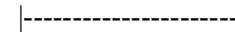

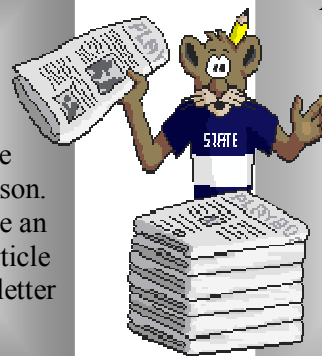
